About the Speaker:

Brian Collins is an Assistant Professor of Philosophy at California Lutheran University. His primary research interests are in Ethics and Political Philosophy with an emphasis on 'political obligation' and the intersection of ethical and political philosophical theories. He is particularly interested in the way which historical figures (e.g. Plato, Aristotle, Bentham, Spinoza, Hume, Locke, Kant, etc.) have developed their ethical and political theories in accord with one another.

Mr. Collins is originally from Wisconsin and earned his B.A. from St. Olaf outside of Minneapolis. He is passionate about education and came to Los Angeles while working with Teach for America as a middle school teacher. He is the founder of the SoCal Philosophy Academy whose goal is to encourage critical philosophical thinking in everyday life. After earning both a Ph.D. and M.A. in Philosophy from The University of Iowa, Brian and his wife returned to Southern California so he could teach at California Lutheran University.
